What happens at Forest School?



Forest school is an exciting opportunity for your child to experience nature and learn outdoors.

At forest school the children learn from first hand experience and develop skills like independence, perseverance and responsibility. These are all skills that will help them become life long learners.



What should we wear?

In the colder weather children will need

- Long sleeved top plus jumper/sweatshirt
- Long warm trousers
- A water proof coat
- Closed toe shoes such as wellies
- Warm hat and gloves.

Who runs forest School ?

Mrs. Bonner is training as a forest school leader, Mrs Clarke , Mrs Broughton and Miss McCulley will be the forest school team.

What will we do there?

There are lots of different games and activities we can do to enhance your child's learning and their knowledge and love of nature.

We will play 123 where are you, we will make magic potions, we will learn to identify animals and plants, we will learn songs and maybe even go on a bear hunt.

Where will we go?

We are so lucky to have a woodland sight on our grounds.

The site is large and has been divided up into forest school 1 and 2.

We will use forest school 1 site for 3 years then move to site 2.

When will we go ?

We will go every Thursday morning for 6 weeks.

What is a forest school session like ?

A forest school session lasts about an hour and a half.
