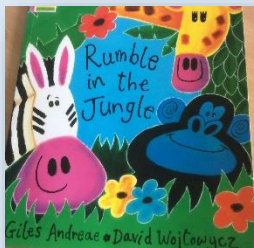


Have you updated your contact details with us?

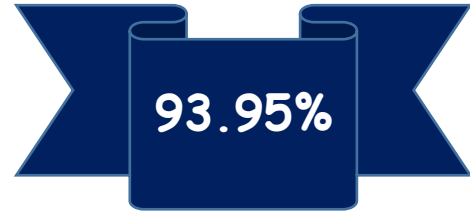
