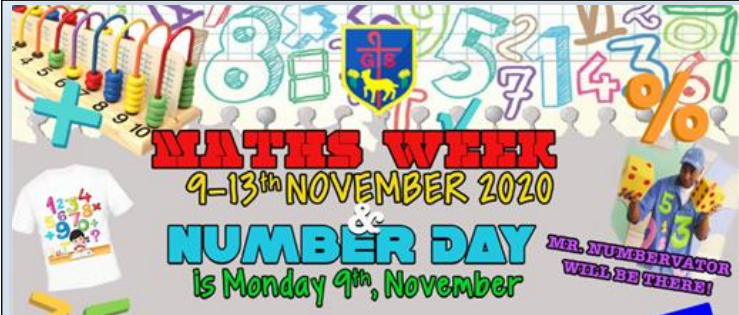

Our winner was Amelie G in Year 5!



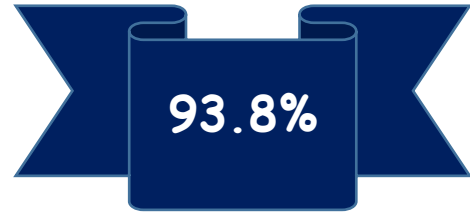

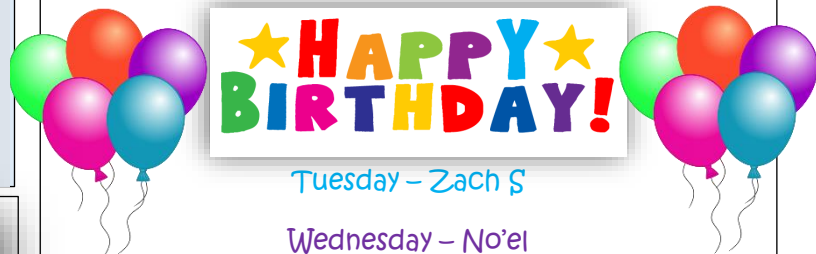

STAGGERED START AND FINISH TIMES:

RN & R1A - Entry via car park gates between 8.35-8.45. Collect at 15.00

1L & Year 2 - Entry via car park gates between 8.55-9.00. Collect at 15.15.
