Class 4P: 96.09%


Class 5A: 96% Class 5C: 94.87% Class 6P: 95.72% Class 6M: 95.63%

The School Aged Immunisation Team will be visiting school on Monday 16th November 2020.

Please go to your ParentMail account for a letter regarding the flu programme including the link to give consent for your child. The live consent form will close 7 days before the planned immunisation session so it is important that you complete and submit your form ASAP if you wish for your child to receive the flu vaccination in school.
