Connecting Classroom Project 2020-2021

We are really happy to bring you news of an exciting project that we are involved in over the coming year with three partner schools in Tanzania!



The project is based on developing the children’s understanding of water pollution and involves two other schools from the Northamptonshire area and three schools from Tanzania: two primary schools and one Secondary school.

Fresh and clean water sources are in danger of extinction due to global warming, rapid population growth, environmental pollution, and the direct mixing of industrial wastes into water resources without any treatment. Water pollution is a global problem and will have more serious consequences in the future if no action is taken now.

The project aims to develop children’s awareness of the sustainability of water at local, national and international level, promote conscious use of available resources, water saving, prevention of water pollution and the importance of water for living things.

Over the year, the children will take part in a range of activities which deal with clean water and sanitation, responsible water consumption (this can be as simple as turning off the tap when you brush your teeth,) and looking at life below water and how we can do more to preserve our seas and oceans.

The children will share their work with the children in Tanzania and will have opportunities to meet each other online to work collaboratively and develop their ideas.

The project will have its own website and so in a time honoured tradition, we will be running a competition for the children of all schools involved to design a logo for the website.

This is a really exciting opportunity for all the pupils involved to develop their understanding of Global Citizenship and we hope to involve the parents, church and wider community in as many aspects of the project as possible.
