Dear Parents / Carers,

With our sleep over approaching this Friday, we wanted to send a reminder of some key points so that it will be a fun, happy and memorable experience for all.

**Clothing:** We have planned several outdoor activities, dependent of course on the weather, including watching a film on a big screen outdoors and having a campfire so it is important that children bring appropriate clothing to keep themselves warm – coat, gloves, hat, sweater and whatever else is appropriate for your child. Of course, we also have wet / cold weather alternatives should they be needed.

**Bedding :** as mentioned on the original letter, each child will need a sleeping bag or the like and to bring their own pillow. An air bed could be brought but only single size please as 20 double beds will just not fit into a classroom!! We will be bringing the gym mats over to put down like camping mats if anyone is finding this element difficult.

**Safety:** A key safety precaution is that NO mobile phones, smart watches or other gadgets will be allowed.

**Food:** NO food, sweets, drinks etc. should be brought in by children, plenty of food will be supplied during the evening and we do have a few children with various food allergies.

**Behaviour:** Finally, we would like to take this opportunity to remind children and parents that children's behaviour should be of a high standard throughout the sleepover. In the event that a child should not uphold high standards of behaviour, staff will be contacting parents and asking them to collect their child. This will be regardless of time and no refund will be given. Staff are volunteering to support this event, and we therefore expect all children to have fun whilst at the same time being on their best behaviour.

**Saturday Morning:** We would ask that parents collect their children from the KS2 playground at 9am.

Please do not hesitate to let us know if there are any extra details, we should know about your child in relation to sleeping over.
