
# SAFEGUARDING IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

The items can be for men, women and children. They should not be wrapped as they will be checked for suitability back at the Hope Centre.

The items will be collected, sorted into categories and then transported to the Hope Centre by the Thomas Becket Minibuses before the end of term.
