Saint	Colour	Date
St. Andrew	Blue	30 th November 2019
St. David	Yellow	1 st March 2020
St. Patrick	Green	17 th March 2020
St. George	Red	23 rd April 2020

The first celebration this year will be for **St. Andrew's house on 9th December 2019** and only the children in **St. Andrew's house** will be wearing their own clothes. They can come in a different blue to their school uniform so they feel special on that day.
