Here are just a few reminders for you:

Children will need to be at school for **8:45am latest**, we will be leaving school promptly as we need to get Warwick Castle in good time and we cannot wait for late comers as we have a workshop very soon after our proposed arrival time so please ensure your child is here in plenty of time. I will open my classroom doors at 8:30.

If medication is needed for the return journey it must be in a sealed in an envelope / clearly labelled with your child's name, instructions and your signature.
